Re: Poll of Congressman Nussle's District Shows Deep Opposition to Bush Privatization Plan

A new poll conducted by SCG Research for the USAction Education Fund has found deep opposition in Iowa's 1st Congressional District to President Bush's plan to privatize Social Security. Over seventy percent of 1st District voters oppose the President's plan for Social Security.

The poll also found that seven out of ten 1st District voters said they were less likely to vote for candidates who support the President's plan for Social Security.

The 1st District poll was part of a larger survey conducted in the Districts of nine members of the House Ways and Means Committee who have not yet indicated their position on the President's Social Security privatization proposals.

The automated poll, sampled the opinions of 873 1st District registered voters between July 14 and 20. It has a margin of error of +/- 3.4%.

The larger national poll sampled a total of 3,018 voters and had a margin of error of +/- 1.8%.

Key 1st District findings include:

- By a margin of 70.64% to 29.36%, voters in this district said they disapproved of President Bush's handling of Social Security.
- Seventy Three percent of 1st District voters think the Bush Social Security plan will cut their Social Security benefits.
- Seventy percent of 1st District voters think the Bush plan will make Social Security weaker.
- Over seventy percent of 1st District voters oppose the President's plan for Social Security.
- Sixty Nine percent of 1st District voters said they would be less likely to vote for a candidate who supports the Bush Social Security plan.

The 1st District results closely mirror results in other Districts represented by undecided Ways and Means Committee Members.
