Re: Poll of Congressman English's District Shows Deep Opposition to Bush Privatization Plan

A new poll conducted by SCG Research for the USAction Education Fund has found deep opposition in Pennsylvania's 3rd Congressional District to President Bush's plan to privatize Social Security. Over seventy two percent of 3rd District voters oppose the President's plan for Social Security.

The poll also found that seven out of ten 3rd District voters said they were less likely to vote for candidates who support the President's plan for Social Security.

The 3rd District poll was part of a larger survey conducted in the Districts of nine members of the House Ways and Means Committee who have not yet indicated their position on the President's Social Security privatization proposals.

The automated poll, sampled the opinions of 453 3rd District registered voters between July 14 and 20. It has a margin of error of +/- 4.8%.

The larger national poll sampled a total of 3,018 voters and had a margin of error of +/- 1.8%.

Key 3rd District findings include:

- By a margin of 72.67% to 27.33%, voters in this district said they disapproved of President Bush's handling of Social Security.
- Seventy Three percent of 3rd District voters think the Bush Social Security plan will cut their Social Security benefits.
- Seventy One percent of 3rd District voters think the Bush plan will make Social Security weaker.
- Over seventy two percent of 3rd District voters oppose the President's plan for Social Security.
- Seventy percent of 3rd District voters said they would be less likely to vote for a candidate who supports the Bush Social Security plan.

The 3rd District results closely mirror results in other Districts represented by undecided Ways and Means Committee Members.
